## Front 9 Tour Northeast Louisiana Middle School/Elementary Tournament Program

- **Program Cost:**
  - Elementary: **\$155 per participant**
  - Middle School: **\$165 per participant**
- **Grades:**
  - Elementary Division: 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grades
    - *Caddies are Allowed in this Division*
  - Middle School Division: 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup>
  - 5<sup>th</sup> graders can play in the Middle school division if the Elementary facility is on the same campus as the Middle School.
  - If an 8<sup>th</sup> grader competes in a high school match, he/she will not be eligible to participate in any middle school match.
  - Front 9 Tour representative will conduct all tournaments.
- **Front 9 Tour run Clinics**
  - One 2 Hour Clinic ([Chenault Park GC](#))
- **School's Boy and Girl teams will be determined by each school's Head Coach.**

- **Teams for tournament play will be scored:**
  - Boys: 5 (A) Team Flighted and 5 (B) Team Flighted Players
  - Girls: 3(A) Team Flighted and 3 (B) Team Flighted Players
  - Elementary Division will be scored Individually.
- **The golf season: Five 9-hole *Stroke Play* matches**
- **One 18-hole championship: (A team), & one 9-hole championship: (B Team) for qualified medalists.**
  - (A Team) Boys will play from the White Tees. (A Team) Girls will play from the Red Tees.
  - (B) All will play from the Red Tees or modified tees which will very in links.
  - Elementary will play from the Florescent Green Cones.



## **Front 9 Tour Northeast Louisiana Middle School/Elementary Spring Program - Continued**

- **Championship Tournament structure: Stroke Play**
  - Boys Top 5 (A Teamers) and Top 5 (B Teamers) Play in the Championship (to be determined by the coach).
  - Girls Top 3 (A Teamers) and Top 3 (B Teamers) Play in the Championship (to be determined by the coach).
  - The Top 20 Boys and top 20 girls with the lowest Season Score average with ties will qualify to play in the Championship. **(top 5 from each team from both (A) and (B) Flights are not included in the individual count)**
  - Top 20 Elementary Flight with ties will qualify to play in the 9 Hole Championship.
- **Trophies awarded At Northeast Louisiana Championship:**
  - Boys & Girls: 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Team both (A) & (B) Flights and Top 3 Medalist for all Flights
- **Front 9 Tour North Louisiana MS Spring Championship(NLSC) Location Trails End Golf Course in Arcadia LA., Date April 22<sup>nd</sup> , 2026**
  - Top 3 (A) Flight and Top 2 (B) Flight teams; Top 10 (A) Flight Boys & Girls individuals; Top 5 (B) Flight Boys & Girls individuals with ties will qualify.
  - **Entry fee for Front 9 Tour (NLSC) is \$65.**
  - **Top 2 teams and Top 10 Medalist from the Front 9 Tour NLSC will qualify to play in the Front 9 Tour State Middle School Championship Location (TBA) Date (TBA).**
  - **Entry fee for Front 9 Tour Front 9 Tour State MS Championship is \$65.**
  - **Roster sheet by February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and participant fee needs to be turned into the Front 9 Tour by February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026.**

## Front 9 Tour Northeast Louisiana Middle School/Elementary Tournament Program General Rules and Guidelines

### ○ Rules of Play:

- The USGA Rules of Golf shall govern play. Supplemental Rules of Play will be provided (if needed) at each site. Carry your Rules Book with you at all times. If you observe a fellow-competitor doing something that might violate a Rule of Golf, you should inform them of their mistake **Immediately**. Otherwise, they may break more rules that will result in more severe penalties. Golf is a game in which we realize that the rules are made to protect the field. By calling a rules infraction you ensure that the competition is fair. Do not be afraid to call a rules infraction. YOU are not penalizing them; it is the Rules of Golf. If you are not comfortable informing your fellow-competitor of their violation, then you should inform a Front 9 Tour Tournament Coordinator as soon as possible and they will handle the situation.
- Pull Carts will be allowed.
- Range finder devices will be allowed per USGA Rules. however local rule will always supersede: If an electronic device noticeably slows your pace of play or the site of the tournament does not allow them, you will not be allowed to use it. If you continue to use them during a round after being told you cannot, you will be disqualified.

### ○ Conduct Guidelines:

- The Front 9 Tour is committed to maintaining sportsmanship, etiquette, and the integrity of the game of golf. With that in mind, the following guidelines for conduct will apply:
  - Any conduct detrimental to a player, his/her equipment, the golf course, the host facility, etc., will not be tolerated.
  - **No use of alcohol, tobacco, or Vaping products.**
  - No drugs or weapons permitted. Police will be notified in the event of a violation.
  - No cell phones allowed during play.
  - No gambling.
  - No abusive language or profanity.
  - No temper tantrums or club throwing. Any misconduct may result in penalties, point reductions and/or disqualification without a refund.
  - We reserve the right to refuse playing privileges to any player whose conduct outside of the Junior Tour is determined to not be in the best interest of the game or the Front 9 Tour.



## **Front 9 Tour Northeast Louisiana Middle School/Elementary Tournament Program Parents, Spectators, and Coaches guidelines**

- **Parents and Spectators:**

- ***These policy will be strictly enforced for the benefit of the players:***

- Parents and spectators are encouraged to attend The Front 9 Tour events. Spectator carts are available for rent at the host facilities discretion. Cost is determined by the host facility. Golf Cart rules must be followed at all times. We ask that you please adhere to the following policies while attending The Front 9Tour Events:
    - Walk or ride only on the cart paths or roughs where cart paths are not accessible. Always be aware of the group behind you.
    - DO NOT talk to the players as this action may be construed as giving advice, resulting in a penalty to the player.
    - **DO NOT attempt to give rulings!** It is the fellow playing partner's responsibility to make a ruling in the absence of a Tour official or a course Marshall.
    - Spectators are encouraged to inform the Front 9 Tour Tournament Coordinators immediately of any rules or etiquette violations. We can only address these situations and limit the violations if they are brought to our attention on site.
    - Cell phones - Turn off or place on vibrate all cellular phones while on the golf course.
    - Spectators are allowed to carry food, water, umbrellas, jackets, towels, etc. for the players.

- **Coaches(Middle School Only): *Coach's carts will be \$15 per team***

- ***Head Coaches and Assistant Coaches will be allowed to coach their team members during, and both can help with locating lost balls and any etiquette violations. Head Coaches and Assistant Coaches must be Declared before the rounds begin.***
  - ***Coaches of individual players are limited to coaching between holes only.***
  - Coaches can use cell phones to communication with Front 9 Tour Tournament Coordinator but will need to keep them on silent mode.
